



INFORMATION

Below are some basic information points for animal rescue groups wishing to participate in Great American Wheels & Wings events benefiting Paws 'n' Wheels for animal welfare. Any questions you have should be directed to info@greatamericanwheelsandwings.com.

1. Participation in any single event is open to any group active in animal rescue, no matter what size group, or species of animals being rescued;
2. Participation by an animal rescue group at a Great American Wheels & Wings event merely involves being present during the event. Participation means having a real presence at the Great American Wheels & Wings event for which a group has committed. Merely leaving literature, banners, posters, or signs at the event does not constitute participation. A booth, canopy and table, are desired but, not absolutely necessary. Any literature for distribution is a plus.
3. In order to participate, at least one representative from each participating animal rescue group must be available to answer questions, to interact with event attendees and be available for any request, or direction, from official Great American Wheels & Wings event staff during the entire operating hours of the event (usually four hours);
4. Any animals, which are available for adoption, being present at an event, are the rescue group's decision. It is not necessary but, can be helpful. However, some locations, such as certain restaurants near highways, and other venues may not be conducive to having animals present. Shade and water are usually available at the airport location but, may not be readily available at others. Be familiar with the location for which your group is committing. Animal rescue groups need to bring the items necessary for the comfort and safety of their animals
5. Participation reservations are on a first come, first served basis. The managing director of Great American Wheels & Wings will determine the total number of animal rescue groups permitted to participate in any single event;
6. At the sole discretion the managing director of Great American Wheels & Wings, any additional animal rescue group indicating a desire to participate in any single event, after the total number of animal rescue groups participating in the event has been determined, may be allowed representation;
7. Any additional animal rescue group allowed representation, after the total number of animal rescue groups participating in the event has been determined, may not participate in the division of any event proceeds;
8. However, ANY animal rescue group represented may independently solicit contributions for their organization;
9. An animal rescue group's adoption policy is up to the individual group. Most groups do not allow animals to go with potential new owners until references, etc. are checked. Your animals available for adoption are your responsibility. Assistance may be available if needed.
10. All animals present at an event must be under positive control (with leashes, cages, carriers, etc.) at all times! Precautions will be taken to help assure the safe operation of all aircraft and vehicles however, accidents can happen. As we all are aware that animals and manmade conveyances **DO NOT** mix, please keep your animals under control and safe! We do not want any devastating events.
11. Any help with the event is appreciated. Promotion of the event is always welcome.
